

Some Dos & Don'ts

When Selecting a University



Look for courses that interest you.

Look for a school that ranks highly in the subjects you're considering. Choose those which best fit you in terms of location, finances, college culture, size, etc



Worry less about the overall university rankings.

Overall, university rankings are important, but they aren't as crucia as the rankings for the subject matter that interests you. For example, Harvard is ranked one of the top universities in the United States, but MIT is ranked higher if you're interested in engineering.



Avoid the temptation to 'check all the boxes' for the sake of it.

Admission counselors recommend that students focus on the suitability of the college based on their area of interest. Don't select a university simply because of its prestige - it should rank highly in the subject area you want to pursue higher studies.
