

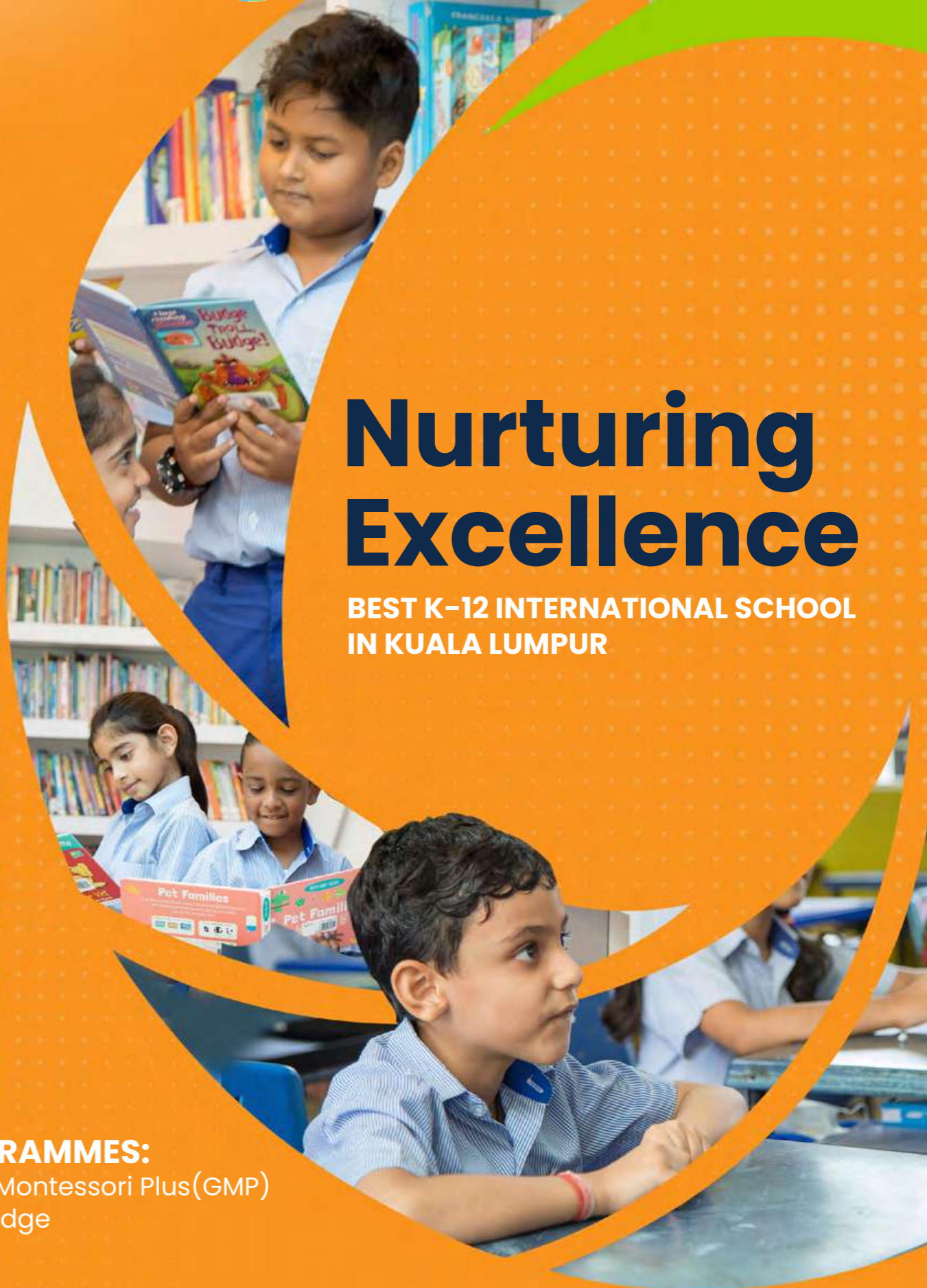

CUSTOMISED PEDAGOGY, GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE

GIIS gives its students a choice of renowned international curricula imparted within a holistic framework to bring out the best overall development of students. Our three main curricula for K12 grades lead to experiential learning, academic training, skills-based and values-based development.



GLOBAL MONTESSORI PLUS

Our award-winning Global Montessori Plus (GMP) programme combines the best of preschool education with the Montessori method of learning. It recognises the uniqueness of each child, and uses new-age methodologies to help students build a strong foundation in the Early Childhood years to prepare them for higher education. Our programme is based on 5 main pillars:



'EXCELERATE' PROGRAMME

By accelerating excellence, this pillar focuses on teaching literacy and numeracy to students. The emphasis is on developing the fluency of four major language skills—listening, speaking, reading and writing. Maths is also introduced as a concept.



MULTI-FACETED LEARNING

This pillar is based on the concept of multiple intelligences inherent in all children. The interdisciplinary approach is designed to challenge, nurture and enhance each child's unique personality. It addresses all eight intellectual brain capacities for holistic development.



iCARE PROGRAMME

Aimed at raising your child's awareness towards the world around them, this programme is highly interactive. It teaches children to engage with community members and care for the environment.



iPLAY PROGRAMME

This pillar ensures students have time for play and exploration. The importance of play is recognised here and gives each child the freedom to learn through free, organised and structured play.

Key Stage 1 (5-7 years old)

Our two-year primary programme focuses on developing languages, teaching mathematical skills and sowing the seeds of scientific inquiry into young minds. It helps build a solid basis for academic and extracurricular activities which are part of our 9GEMS holistic framework.



Key Stage 2 (8-11 years old)

This four-year programme introduces students to advanced levels of skills in all subject areas. Assessments are carried out by teachers and peers to check the progress of the students through exams and integrated progress checkers.



Key Stage 3 (11-14 years old)

The Cambridge Lower Secondary Programme (CLSP) is a unique blend of STEAM subjects, Arts as well as Sports, to provide learners with rich experience in secondary schooling. It is designed for nurturing proactive and resourceful learners and is best for students aspiring to study Cambridge IGCSE in higher grades.



Key Stage 4 (14-16 years old)

The International General Certificate Secondary Education (IGCSE) provides a remarkable depth to students as they move toward their final schooling years and aim to pursue A-levels or IB Diploma. They are expected to pass examinations in at least seven subjects including two languages.





CBSE CURRICULUM

CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education) curriculum focuses on synchronising rigours of academics with extracurricular activities to provide a complete learning experience. The CBSE approach enables students with the work ethic necessary to excel while also developing creative skills, polishing interpersonal skills and adding outstanding value to personalities.

The curriculum involves a continuous and comprehensive evaluation system to ensure performance standards are met and exceeded. Learning starts with basic facts which increase in complexity and depth as students move to higher classes.

Assessment

There are 4 terms and the term-end exams are conducted at the end of each term. There is a final exam at the end of the fourth term.

Faculty

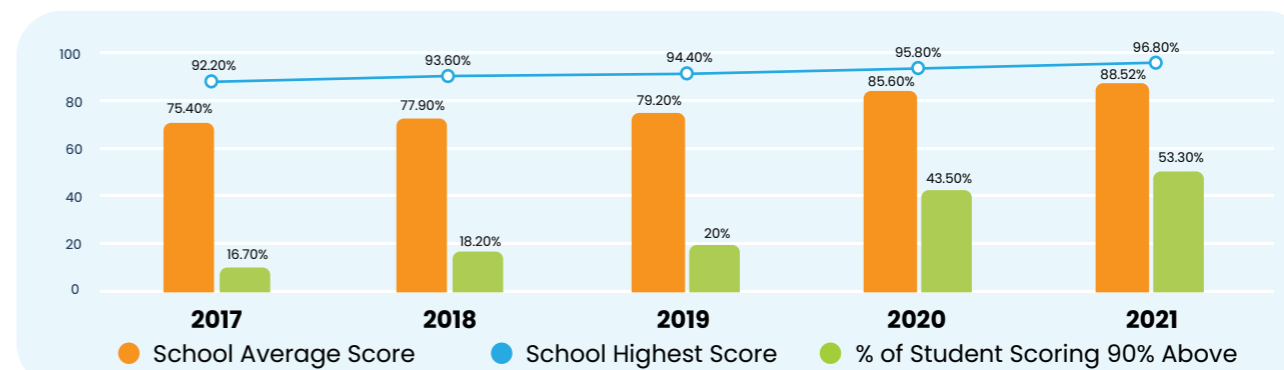

Activity

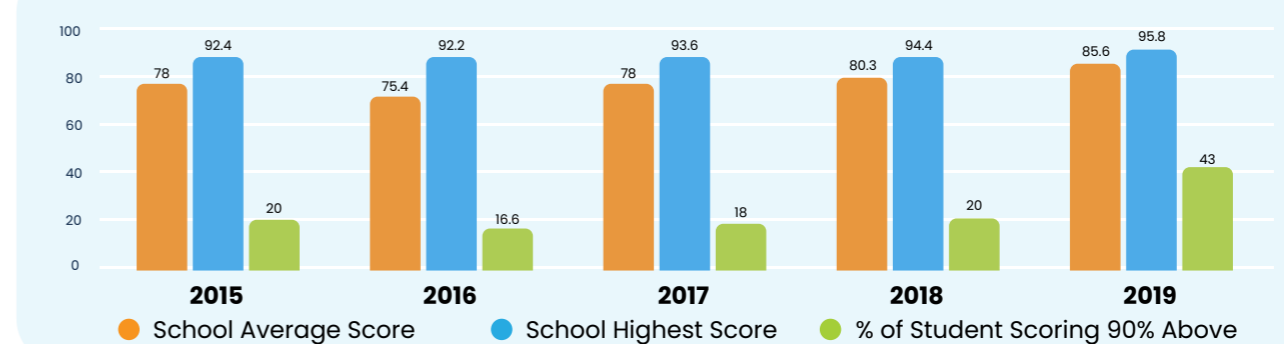

The scholarship is aimed for students who are residents of Malaysia, including the existing student fraternity. This scholarship extends support through financial assistance for parents across financial spectrums.



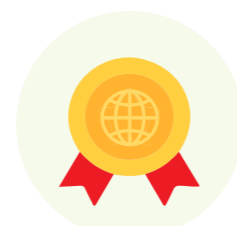
9GEMS Holistic Development Scholarship
